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Romuald Gozdawa-Gołębiowski is Professor of Linguistics at the Institute of English Studies, University of Warsaw, Poland. His research interests include new trends and developments in foreign and second language teaching methodology, in particular in the areas of pedagogical grammar, formulaicity, testing, Content

and Language Integrated Learning, intercultural communicative competence and those aspects of theoretical and applied linguistics which have a bearing on language teaching (contrastive Polish-English syntax, corpus linguistics, English as a lingua franca, Euro-English). He has written a monograph on interlanguage growth, published over forty papers in academic journals in Poland and abroad, as well as four manuals of English grammar for Polish secondary school learners and adult users. He has co-authored a testing manual and six collections of tests of English for Polish learners and co-developed attainment standards and the model of foreign language testing at the University of Warsaw.

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
